The ski resort and the Ten Mile Range provide a stunning backdrop to this outdoor playground with limitless activities and more than 200 sports shops, boutiques and art galleries. Victorian Breckenridge is authentic and vibrant, yet down to earth (affordable) and unpretentious. Candy colored Victorian storefronts line Main Street. It's like a scene from an Old West movie, a genuine old mining town, (greatly expanded). The nightlife is exciting - walk to 80 restaurants, bars and taverns. Don't miss the public Recreation Center with pool, children's waterslide, and two indoor rock-climbing walls.

**Ski Areas: Breckenridge, Keystone, Arapahoe Basin- ([keystone.snow.com](http://keystone.snow.com); [arapahoebasin.com](http://arapahoebasin.com))**

Breckenridge is among the top mountain destinations in North America. Your interchangeable lift ticket will be good at Keystone and Arapahoe Basin, also. (These Vail Resort tickets are also good for a limited # days at Vail and Beaver Creek). With 2,208 acres spread over three mountains and served by 28 lifts, you will have 146 trails to choose from. Base area is at 9,600 feet. Try out Breckenridge's new Imperial lift, now the highest chairlift in North America. Explore all four famed Peaks 7, 8, 9 and 10.

Keystone offers three mountains on 2,870 acres, the largest in Summit County, served by 20 lifts, including two gondolas. You will have 117 trails to choose from. It boasts two base areas, the original base area and the recently developed River Run. This is a pedestrian village with curving stone-paved plazas, complete with shops, restaurant, micro-brewery and après ski. Be sure to check out the beautiful, gladed trails of the Outback.

Arapahoe Basin- no trip to Summit County would be complete without spending a day enjoying 69 trails on the highest skiable terrain in North America. It is located on 490 acres served by 6 lifts and features Pallavicini, one of the most famous expert runs in North America. The base area, at 10,780 feet, is a throw back to the sixties. The resort is independently owned but has a joint marketing agreement with Vail Resort.

**Trail's End offers supreme accommodations in a premium location which is Ski In/Ski Out.** It has private access via footbridge to the Lower Peak 9 Base Area and Quicksilver SuperChair. Also near downtown, Trail's End Condominiums are steps to dining, shopping and all that Breckenridge has to offer.

Skiers are greeted by the grand lobby and fireplace. These comfortable units feature a private balcony, gas fireplace and well-equipped kitchen and wireless high speed internet.

The drive from Denver to the Town of Breckenridge is approximately 2 ½ hours.
