# 2013 Ski Trips

All day/weekend ski trips depart from 5 Municipal Way, Langhorne, PA 19047. This is the Middletown Township Police Building, which is two lights north of Maple Avenue (Rt. 213), off of North Flowers Mill Road. (directions and map on the web site). Prices include lift tickets, transportation on a lavatory-equipped bus, videos and refreshments on the bus, driver's tip, lodging, meals, and a box dinner on the return trip home. Friday departure times for weekend trips: Sunday River/Wildcat 4:00 PM. Most accommodations can be priced for double, triple or quad occupancy. Indicate your choice on the waiver form.

Children 18 years or younger may qualify for rate reductions when staying with their parents. Agreements with lodges vary, so check with Maureen to see what is most beneficial to your family.

PLEASE NOTE that you must be a member to go on ski trips and you must fill out a color-coded waiver form with your initial deposit. If you make the required 50% deposit 60 days in advance of the trip, you receive a \$10 discount off of the total cost of each weekend trip and are entered in the raffle for a \$100 discount. Balance is due a minimum of 2 weeks prior to departure.

Rates listed are per person, tax and gratuities included.

#### **BRECKENRIDGE, COLORADO**

December 26 -January 2

#### \$1,609 (air, house, shuttle, lifts)

Ski 6 days. We are staying in a private home near Peak 8, just a short walk to 4 O'clock Run. There is a private outdoor hot tub for our après ski relaxation. We are buying Epic Local Passes to get the best value. These are also good at Keystone and Arapahoe Basin. We have purchased Southwest Airfare on our own so we won't have to pay extra luggage fees. TIGNES, FRANCE

January 11 - 20

\$2,539 Double \$2,461 Triple \$2,803 Single Six day lift ticket without carre neige ski insurance is 235 euros. Our 11th time returning to L'Espace Killy – the combined resorts of Tignes and Val d'Isère, with over 100 lifts and 25,000 acres spreading across 6 valleys. Six days to ski on endless choices of trails for skiers of all abilities: from the high alpine glaciers to the village below the Tignes dam. We will be staying seven nights in the ski-in, ski-out three-star plus *Village Montana Hotel*. A huge breakfast buffet will be served daily and in the evening gourmet French dinners. Relax in the heated outdoor pool, Jacuzzi and saunas. Last night in Lyon. \$800 deposit due now to hold your reservation. Insurance: \$143.

Ski 4½ days. Join us on the Eastern PA Ski Council Melting Pot bus trip for Quebec's famous Winter Carnival. Enjoy the old world charm of the upper and lower city. We will be staying in the 5-Star *Fairmont Le Chateau Frontenac*. Skiing will include the resorts of Mont-Sainte-Anne, Stoneham and LeMassif. Enjoy the cuisine, ice sculptures, masquerade ball, some meals plus unique shopping at your doorstep. There is much to see and do for both skiers and non-skiers. Optional tours available. Payment schedule is now at \$400 per person to be sure you get a seat on the bus.


